





Perimeter security

The level of protection afforded to any given building or area is normally determined by the level of risk from intrusion or other criminal activity and ideally will comprise of several different but complimentary 'layers' of protection.

In this respect, Perimeter Protection, in its various forms, is the ideal first level of protection; providing both an early warning of attempted intrusion, as well as deterring and/or delaying entry of intruders.



Access control

Access Control is, quite simply, a means of managing the access of people and vehicles, where appropriate, to buildings, car parks, vulnerable or sensitive areas, lifts, vending machines and other electronic equipment.

Entry Control has always been an important factor in the fight against crime, but at a time of economic difficulty and widespread international tension, it is even more important to be security conscious.

Border Security

National borders, whether at airports, seaports, or on land, present a unique set of security challenges.

Westminster are able to advise on and provide a complete range of solutions from long range perimeter detection systems for the physical border; people, vehicle and container screening for checkpoints; and identity checking systems for customs and immigration purposes. resulting in skilled and able workforce.

WG ID Border Control Immigration Solution

The WG ID Border Control Immigration Solution can be deployed as a stand-alone or multiple location integrated system.

At the immigration control point the system will be used to:

- Capture photos of travellers;
- Interface with passport readers to extract bio-data from passports;
- Open / read ICAO chips;
- Provide reports against data sets;
- Record and store arriving and departure details for passengers;
- Swipe travel documents;
- Verify or register biometrics such as finger prints.

The captured information is immediately used to:

- Check against profiles;
- Check against watch lists;
- · Check against visa information;
- Highlight and displays any history on the travel documents;
- Link a traveller to specific flights or airlines;
- Store data locally and if required share with other organisations globally.





WG Advanced Passenger Information (API) Solution

The WG Advanced Passenger Information Solution can be deployed as a stand-alone or multiple location integrated system.

The solution extends the features of WG ID Border Control Immigration solution incorporating Advanced Passenger Information controls.

Functionality

- Accurate passenger data for both individual flights and travel in/out of the country;
- Can link to Interpol to verify passengers and travel documents;
- Extends Border Control to the passenger's point of departure;
- Improves passenger experience whilst increasing throughput.

Advance Passenger Information (API)

The API module accepts inputs from various forms of transport carriers to process Advance Passenger Information and, where appropriate, return interactive responses in the form of passenger Board / No-Board decisions. This effectively extends your border control to the passenger's point of departure. Interactive API decisions are based on targeting and intelligence rules that are configured to meet client needs and dynamic threats.

Passenger Name Record (PNR)

Passenger Name Record (PNR) and Specific Transport Types (STT) entries are supported and can receive information from carriers on various transport modes, with automatic data conversion.

Targeting and Intelligence

The system supports many types of watch lists; for example identifying Persons of Interest and passengers on No-Fly lists. Green lists allow registered travellers and Visa holders to be efficiently and speedily routed, while configurable Business Rules can be defined to target potential threats and problems. The system also highlights trends using various types of travel formats.

Targeting Centre

Support staff can view the entire Border Operation, reviewing staff levels, passenger counts, problems and threats; any potential threats and problems are evaluated – in-real time – before a passenger boards.

Interpol Checks

API data can be cross-checked against Interpol's databases to prevent passengers with stolen or fraudulent passports from traveling. Interpol can also be cross-checked for any domestic travel if required.

Checkpoint Types

The following devices are available for use at both International and Domestic checkpoints:

- Mobile scanners;
- Fixed control;
- Electronic gate.

Container screening - two Asian ports


Following changing local regulations two ports in an Asian country were looking to upgrade their security screening with new 7Mev container scanners.

Westminster were selected by both ports for the provision and on-going maintenance of two advanced containers screening solutions.

Westminster's solutions consisted of two fixed 7Mev portal x-ray scanners which were built, shipped and installed in the ports. Each scanners has the ability to scan up to 150 forty foot containers per hour and provides material discrimination to allow easy identification of organic substances such as drugs and explosives.







Case study

Managed services port screening - West Africa

Westminster Group Plc operate a managed service contract to exclusively provide port screening services at a container port in West Africa.

Following a lengthy evaluation process, a contract was awarded to Westminster to provide port screening services for an initial period of ten years, commencing 1 July 2021.


The 10+ year contract is based on Westminster's proven Build-Operate-Transfer managed services model, successfully deployed elsewhere around the world, under which governments and facility operators can upgrade their security operations at no direct cost.

Westminster will provide all the screening systems, warehousing and infrastructure required to undertake screening and intrusive search of import containers, maintain and operate the systems and provide comprehensive training services to customs and other staff throughout the term of the agreement.

Oil production facility

Westminster protects this important oil production facility from seaborne incursion by deploying a floating security barrier.

Westminster worked with the client to design various innovative solutions to protect the facility and the final design included the supply and installation of a 200m floating marine security barrier, one of a number of solutions from the company's extensive marine security portfolio of products and services.





Case study

Tower of London

Westminster is contracted to supply security services to help protect the historic Royal Palace and Fortress of the Tower of London.

The Tower of London is a world-renowned iconic castle and World Heritage Site, built by William the Conqueror in 1078, and has served as a Royal Palace, a fortress and a prison over the centuries.

Security of such a landmark building, which is open to the public, is paramount and Westminster has been contracted to provide inter alia, professional security services to the pedestrian and vehicular entrances.

Case study

Palace of Westminster

Westminster has been contracted, for a minimum of 5 years, to replace and maintain the security screening equipment at the Palace of Westminster, together with the provision of other ancillary services.

The project includes the removal of existing systems and the installation and maintenance of new advanced X-Ray Screening and associated systems to screen people and baggage entering this iconic building.





Case study

Managed services port screening - Ghana

The new Tema Container Port in Ghana, a \$1billion investment project by MPS, officially commenced operations on 28 June 2019.

Expanding the port's capacity from 1 million Twenty-foot Equivalent Units ('TEU') pa to over 3.5 million pa, creating a world-class container port operation with some of the largest and most advanced Ship-to-Shore cranes in the world. The port has advanced automated processing systems including the container screening solutions, ensuring that there will be 100% screening of all containers entering or leaving the port.

Westminster were selected as the Technical Partner for MPS as part of a 5 year renewable agreement. By deploying an expert team to the port and undertaking the recruitment, training and deployment of the screening personnel and the setup and management up of the screening offices, logistics and operations Westminster was able to quickly and efficiently bring the screening systems up to full capacity and maintain those systems providing Ghanaian Customs with the information they need.

United Nations mission in Sudan UNMIS

Westminster was awarded a major contract to provide a sophisticated electronic security surveillance system to protect the new United Nations premises in Khartoum, Sudan.

The project consists of a number of high performance surveillance cameras capable of observation, both internally and externally around the complex, in zero lighting conditions as well as in the extremes of the environmental weather experienced in the region.

The system, which will be undertaken by Westminster's specialist technicians based in the Sudan in association with Westminster's local agents, will provide a high level of security to the complex 24 hours a day against attempted intrusion, infiltration or terrorist activity.

The system is monitored and controlled from a sophisticated Control & Command Suite with all camera pictures and recordings available, via secure encryption, to the UN command network.







Case study

Canadian Nexen Petroleum



Westminster were awarded a contract for the supply of specialist long range perimeter fence detection solution to protect several of Nexen's production sites.

Westminster's specialist perimeter detection system can be fitted to perimeter fencing structures or covertly buried below the ground, providing very high levels of detection whilst advanced filtering technology eliminates most causes of false alerts.


The system is capable of monitoring tens or even hundreds of kilometres of perimeter or border fencing without the need for any 'in field' electronics, power supplies or analysers and yet can pinpoint the location of any incident to within a few metres.

The contract, which was managed in conjunction with Westminster's Middle East office involved several months work and was completed in 18 Months.

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National Bank of Sudan

Westminster was awarded the prestigious contract to provide the extensive security systems and equipment required to protect the new Headquarters. Building against both criminal and terrorist attacks.



Westminster was chosen to provide the security protection services on the basis of superior design and performance criteria against fierce competition from a number of international companies.


The contract involved numerous electronic systems integrated into a common Control & Command suite including a Fire Suppression System, Intruder Detection Systems, Access Control, Perimeter Detection Systems, CCTV surveillance, Walk Through Metal Detection Gates, X-Ray Baggage Scanners, Flood Detection Systems, Time & Attendance Equipment & Entry Barriers etc.

Westminster, in addition to providing the electronic protection systems, also provided the vault doors and cash in transport equipment together with specialised fork lift trucks for use in the vault areas.

Case study

Complete Airport Security

Westminster was awarded the contract to take over the complete security operations within a West African International Airport.



The project is, a 15 year contract to provide the complete ground security services at the airport, including the perimeter security of the airport, passenger security throughout the terminal and passenger and baggage screening during check-in, security checkpoint and prior to boarding.

The project covers both the provision of the AVSEC security guard force, the development and implementation of robust and internationally recognised procedures and systems and the installation of state of the art detection and surveillance systems & equipment and the ongoing maintenance and upgrade of such.



As part of the contract Westminster deployed a highly experienced management team and took on the 100+ strong security team. Westminster have implemented advanced training programs to increase the knowledge and performance of all staff.

Westminster has also provided a dog detection team trained in the detection of explosives and narcotics quickly and effectively increasing the security of air travel. This deployment whilst not a requirement of the contract has been implemented by Westminster as a commitment to our vision of developing a internationally recognised standard of aviation excellence.

British Embassy Paris

The British Embassy Paris selected Westminster to provide a solution to physically secure the three entrances into their building from vehicular access.

Following a site survey, Westminster recommended that electrically operated, remote controlled rising bollards be sited at each entrance so as to create dual security of both an inner and outer security barrier to combat vehicle borne attacks.

Fixed static bollards provide additional protection from Vehicle borne improvised explosive device (VBIED) by keeping vehicles away from Vulnerable areas.

With the British Embassy occupying a strategic position in the centre of Paris aesthetics of the proposed solution was also a key consideration.

The security bollards, which are controlled by an entrance automation system, allow authorised personnel to enter safely and securely whilst maintaining security against unauthorised vehicle entry at all times.

Westminster's range of security bollards are designed and manufactured by engineers with significant experience in the fields of high security and access control. Security bollards are a highly dependable yet unobtrusive form of security which will easily interface with the wide range of security solutions offered by Westminster.




Case study

Covert Surveillance Vehicle

Westminster was awarded a contract from a African National Government to supply a number of bespoke mobile surveillance vehicles and equipment to assist with urban policing and state security.

The vehicles which involve the deployment of a wide array of audio & visual surveillance, covert tracking and secure communication systems. These systems include covert vehicle mounted surveillance cameras, covert audio recording equipment two way van to operative communication systems with body worn surveillance cameras all transmitted in real time to the vehicle.








The interior of each vehicle is fully equipped to allow the monitoring of all audio and visual feeds as well as incorporating advanced tracking and security management software for detailed incident management. The vehicle is fully covert with the interior fully shielded from heat, RF and other interference and detection and is fully equipped with climate control.

As part of the contract Westminster has provided a state of the art Command & Control centre from which these vehicles and other security solutions are monitored and controlled.

The bespoke mobile surveillance vehicles are linked in real time with the control centre by fully mobile satellite communications allowing the Command & Control centre to fully manage operations from multiple vehicles simultaneously allowing for large scale policing operations to be effectively implemented.



Case study

Consultancy Services

Westminster was awarded an ongoing contract for several years from Mobily, part of the Etisalat group, Saudi Arabia to carry out a series of consultancy project for the Saudi Arabian mobile phone giant.

The consultancy projects focused on Mobily's infrastructure across Saudi Arabia covering hundreds of buildings and compounds both security and building management systems and the requirements for countrywide monitoring and reporting.

In addition Westminster have been requested to assist with the relocation of the HQ into their new prestigious complex consisting of three tower buildings. Looking at the existing security infrastructure and how this can be enhanced and expanded to suit their profile, including the deployment of security screening and additional advanced surveillance technologies.

Case study

Specialist Marine Security Net

Westminster was awarded a prestigious contract to protect the new Nagaa Hammadi Dam complex on the river Nile in Egypt.

The contract is to supply and install an advanced security net across the river Nile; to prevent access to the dam from either vessels or divers and to protect the hydraulic control structure from any floating or submerged objects.

The security net comprises a steel wire mesh with an advanced fibre optic detection cable attached. Any attempted attack on the net will signal an alarm and indicate the location of attack within the security control room. The net, spanning the entire width of the river Nile, will be fitted with an automatic gate which can be remotely opened and closed from within the control room.


